1.0 Background

The Sr. Highway Engineering Specialist/team leader will work in close coordination with the program director of PMO and provide assistance to the Sr. Bridge/structure engineering specialist, Sr. Quantity/ cost engineering specialist, Sr. Material/pavement engineering specialist and Sr. Contract Management specialist.

- Provide leadership, set standards and provide coaching for a team of Design Engineers.
- Demonstrate excellence in Design Engineering skills.
- Responsible for the compilation and accuracy of Design History files.

- Check the provided road design with respect to the drainage requirements
- Check the provided design in terms of safety and access Review the provided design BoQ against the design.
- Conduct site visit deemed necessary by MPW in regards to specific issues of the PMO projects.
- Require site visits, at least one in a month.
- Any other task assigned by the program director.
- Analyze survey reports, maps, drawings, blueprints, aerial photography, and other topographical or geologic data to plan projects.
- Road network damage assessments leading to and in flood-damaged areas.
- Attending in technical meeting for Highway issues.
- Ensuring that all designs are completed to the highest standards, based on initial survey data provided to the Design Unit by the Surveyors.
- Analyze and solve technical problems and provide solutions in a timely manner.
